Dear Parents and Carers

IMPORTANT: Year 7 End of Year Activity Day - Amendment to previous arrangements

Miss Barber, Head of Year, has previously written to you regarding our planned End of Year 7 trip to Ninja Warrior Gloucester for either the 13th or 14th July.

I am sorry to inform you that Ninja Warriors Gloucester went into receivership just before half-term and the trip is no longer able to take place. To avoid disappointment, we have arranged for a company called 'Wise Up' to provide an on-site activity day instead on Monday 13th July. All Year 7 pupils will need to wear their PE kit for the day. 'The Hub Challenge' will see our Year 7s working in groups of 12 to complete as many of the 32 problem-solving and team-building tasks as they can manage in friendly competition against the other groups. Whilst we appreciate pupils were looking forward to being off-site, we are hoping that the rearranged activity will still provide a fun-filled day for all.

In terms of a comparison to the Ninja Warrior Gloucester trip, the activities will take place from the start of lesson two and finish just before the end of the school day, meaning Year 7 will be able to spend more time undertaking the challenges.

The Ninja Warrior Gloucester trip involved food being provided for pupils: this is not an option for the activity day and pupils will now need to bring a packed lunch or purchase food from the canteen during lunchtime as they would usually on a normal school day. The cost of the Ninja Warrior Gloucester trip was slightly more than the cost of the new activity day. As a consequence, we will use the excess money to provide pupils with some iced refreshments or similar, based on whatever the weather is planning to do on the day.

The Ninja Warrior Gloucester trip option was taken down from Parent Pay just before half-term whilst arrangements were being made. If you are yet to pay for your child, please could you do so by logging into ParentPay and choosing the 'Year 7 End of Year Activity Day' option. Through selecting this option, you will also need to provide consent for the trip and acknowledgement that the school currently holds the correct emergency contact details and allergy information for your child on My Child At School (MCAS). If you wish to check or change any information, please log-in to the MCAS app and select the 'Data Collection Form' option or email changes directly to the school - office@bredon.worcs.sch.uk. We request that all outstanding payments are made by **Tuesday 9th June 2026**.

Any pupil eligible for Pupil Premium will not be charged for the visit. Please just log-in to ParentPay and choose the 'Year 7 End of Year Activity Day - Pupil Premium' option and confirm consent before Tuesday 9th June.

If you have already provided payment and consent, you do not need to take any further action.
