Define it: To describe something that seems impossible, contradictory, or unlikely, yet is true.

Use it: Paradoxically, the more we know, the more we identify an increasing number of questions to which we as yet have no answers.

Deconstruct it: originates from the Greek paradoxos ("contrary to expectation"), formed by combining para- ("contrary to") and dokein ("to think, seem, or appear").

Antonym: typically, normally
