Define it: To subject (food or drink) to cold in order to chill or preserve it, typically by placing it in a refrigerator.

Use it: Refrigerate the cake after you frost it so that the frosting doesn't melt.

Read and say it:

Deconstruct it: from Latin *refrigerat-* 'made cool', from the verb *refrigerare*, from *re-* 'back' + *frigus, frigori-* 'cold'.
